

Forest Avenue Structure



Location: 650 South Forest Avenue

On the corner of South Forest Avenue and Willard Street one half block south of South University Avenue.

Interesting Facts: This attractive stainless steel and concrete structure was constructed as a partnership between the City of Ann Arbor and the University of Michigan and completed in July 2001, and is operated for the benefit of both community and University, with parking spaces allocated for each use.

Size of Current Structure: 854 parking spaces, including 20 handicap-accessible spaces; 577 spaces are public parking, with the remainder administered by the University. (height restriction 7'8")

Rates: Monthly public parking permits are provided at \$125/month, and hourly parking is provided at \$0.80/hour. University faculty and staff are provided parking with a "blue" parking placard and a special plastic windshield card.
